Interview 35 %

Canada Latina Pageants titleholders must be able to Express themselves and project a pleasant personality at all times. Delegates should wear a dress, cocktail suit or pantsuit for the interview.



Bathing to Suit 15%

Canada Latina Pageants titleholders must be able Project their own personal sense of style. This segment will be very much like a runway bathing suit show. All bathing suits will be appropriate and heels no higher than 5"

AREAS OF COMPETITION

Evening gown 30%

Canada Latina Pageants titleholders must carry themselves with dignity, grace, poise, and elegance. Outfits should be age appropriate and heels no higher than 5".



Photogenic 20%

Canada Latina Pageants titleholders will appear in print advertising throughout the year's reign. As representatives of our pageant system winners must possess photographic appeal, and the ability to project an image, in print, that is consistent with beauty and elegance. Our titleholders define our system. Photography is the medium through which the public most often is introduced to any pageant scoring. Photos may be with or without your sash. It can be a headshot, full length, or $\frac{3}{4}$ length. Your picture MUST look like you and should not be overly retouched.

Appearances & Bonus Points

Delegates can add up to 5 bonus points to their overall score. You must first make 4 appearances before bonus points go into effect (this is only for girls within Ontario, Ottawa and Quebec) Girls outside these areas, will get each a bonus point for each appearance you make with your sash at any community event. After 4 appearances, a point will be given to the delegate when an appearance is made with supporting pictures. (8 appearances = 5 bonus points) Delegate must have their sash on in the photo to be accepted as an appearance. The Directors has the right to refuse any appearance.

Miss Publicity will be awarded to the delegate with the most appearances Every appearance must be documented with photos. Please note that going out to dinner with friends and wearing your sash is not a valid appearance. Attending an event, visiting queens, judging a pageant, emceeing, hospital/shelter visits, guest speakers, etc. are valid appearances.

- Ages between 18-28 years of age (if under 18, delegate must have fully consent by parents or guardian)
- Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, Current of Prior Student/work visa. **MUST BE ABLE TO TRAVEL**
- Has no Children nor is Married
- Has Latina/Hispanic background by parents or descendant or is Latina/Hispanic by birth



August 19th – Orientation, Professional Photoshoots (**Portrait, Bikini, Gown**) & Official Delegate Video.

Lunch will be provided (**Please bring water and snacks as necessary**)

8:30 - 10:30AM Orientation

10:30AM - 12:30PM – Make up / hair touch ups

11:30AM - Photoshoot starts.

5:30PM – Day will be over.

August 19th, 20nd, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th REHEARSALS (DANCE COREOGRAPHY & RUNWAY WALKS) **MANDATORY PRACTISES**

August 22nd – Pink Cocktail Party / Judge Interviews

August 25th - Gala Night.

Radio & TV Interviews – TBD date closer to pageant week.

Orientation & Gift exchange

Some pageants require delegates to bring a small gift for other delegates. This is referred to as "swaps". Canada Latina Pageants does NOT require swaps. However, over the years some delegates have chosen to bring little trinkets to their sister queens. Also, if you do bring gifts for delegates in your division or all. The choice is up to you. Gifts can be distributed at Orientation.



CLASSES

You will receive a total of **8 classes**:

- 2 - Make up classes – June 2023 (2.5 hour each)
- 3 - Runway classes – May, June 2023 (1.5 hour each)
- 2 - Public Speaking/ Presentation classes – May, June 2023 (1.5 hour each)
- 1 - Etiquette & Protocol / photo posing class – May 2023 (1.5 hour)

ENTRY FEE

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS:

1 Pay in full- 15% discount Total to pay \$1445 + (\$200 will be reimbursed from casting payment)

3 Instalment payment of the \$1500, since \$200 has already been paid by casting call - \$500 then onwards. The full payment of \$1500 must be paid by June 15th.

1st payment - \$500 – May 1st

2nd payment - \$500 – May 20th

3rd payment - \$500 – June 15th
